MASTERS' PROGRAM: NOV 7- NOV 19, 2016

We were blessed beyond measure to have brother Jerry Bates teach these Masters' students from three different countries that is Tanzania, Malawi and Zambia. Brother Bates taught advanced Hermeneutics and the Gospel of John. It was indeed a blessing to host this lectureship here at CBI.



KYELA FUNERAL NOV 18, 2016

This was a sad event to the churches of Christ in Kyela to lose one of the greatest brothers and a preacher of God's word! That brother by the name of Michael passed away Thursday 27 Nov, 2016, when we received the information, we were all disturbed in our mind since brother Michael was a great and sound Christian. When we arrived there, we found that the church in the respective area had prepared lessons to be taught there. The following were the lessons and people who taught:

- i. The hope of eternal life: By Isaiah Mwantimwa (Kyela local preacher)
- ii. The meaning of death (Kapange from Malawi)
- iii. Repentance By Joseph Haonga from CBI

CBI INTERVIEW NOV 19,2016

Once again, we were tremendously blessed to Interview new students for 2017 here at CBI. We interviewed seventeen Swahili students for the intake 2017 but we missed fifteen students from Mwanza, two from Kagera and also two from Dar es Salaam. This was due to distances and costs, therefore, we are trying to set up a plan on how to access them with the interview.

On the English side, we Interviewed four English students and we still have 5 Congolese refugees and three Tanzanians. We are also planning to set up an interview for the refugees and these local students. We need to hear from you brethren so that we can release the results and start getting them prepared.

NOV 20, RETURN TO THE BIBLE SEMINARS

There was another seminar at Mapangala Church of Christ and 52 people attended the Seminar. Peter Kamatula (CBI English program teacher) taught a lesson on “Spiritual Blessings”. Alphonse Simion (a recent CBI graduate) taught on “Women in the Church.” As a result of this campaign, there were two baptisms!



NOV 20, 2016 FRIENDSHIP SEMINAR MBOZI (BARA)



This is a new place where we have started new a Congregation of 40 people. This past weekend, we held a “Friendship Seminar” which is an opportunity for area-wide congregations to assemble together in fellowship, edification and to evangelize. During this seminar, Ezekiel Harrison (CBI English program teacher) taught on “Christian Conduct,” Elijah Vundwe (CBI Master’s program student) taught on “Christian Growth,” Joseph Haonga (CBI Swahili Director) taught on “Sound Doctrine,” and Fred Mwashiwawa (local preacher) taught on “Worship.” The Lord blessed the church with three baptisms at this seminar.

Also we have 9 baptisms from house to house evangelism held by Alphonse Simion and Fred Geogory our CBI former students. There was also one baptism at the Airport Church of Christ where our brother Peter Kamatula serves as a preacher. Therefore, the total results for these two weeks is **15**

baptisms. We Thank the LORD for the increase and we always ask for your prayers as we all serve our Heavenly Father.

NB: Also, the Iyawaya Congregation is very thankful for being helped with the church building.
